Day 12 - Friday 03 Jul 2026: Hochiminh city Arrival (own tickets)

Upon arrival **Tan Son Nhat airport**, after clearing all customs procedures, please proceed to exit gate and look for your guide who will be waiting at the lobby, holding the Trails of Indochina signboard with your name on it. If you cannot locate your guide, please come to the closest Information booth and have them call the emergency number **(+84) 9 1871 3456**. Your guide will come to meet you and transfer you to hotel.

Day 13 - Saturday 04 Jul 2026: Full day City tour

Meet your guide at the hotel's lobby to start your tour. With over eight million inhabitants and four million motorbikes, Saigon is truly a city that never sleeps. Despite its modernity, Saigon maintains a strong link to the past and our walking tour takes in some of the city's most historic landmarks. Transfer to **Dong Khoi Street** downtown to visit some of the beautiful French colonial-era buildings from the late 19th and early 20th century. Appreciate the splendidly restored exteriors of the **Saigon Opera House** and the **Notre Dame Cathedral**, a red brick edifice with twin spires constructed from materials imported from France (entrance is not permitted due to renovation). Then head across the square to the **Central Post Office**, completed in 1891. A short drive away is **the former Presidential Palace**, the headquarters of the Saigon Government during the American War. Continue to the elegant **City Hall** (the former Hotel de Ville) which is one of Saigon's most stunning colonial monuments especially when floodlit at night. Experience Saigon's famed **street coffee culture** while your guide provides insights into daily life in Saigon.

This afternoon, visit **War Remnants Museum** for a vivid perspective of the American War through the eyes of the Vietnamese. We then drive to **Chinatown** to visit the **Cho Lon**, the old market of Chinese community. Continue your visit to **FITO**, the first museum of traditional medicine in Vietnam, offering an insightful look into the history and application of traditional medicine in everyday life before returning to your hotel.

Due to the anticipated completion of the renovation project for Saigon Notre-Dame Cathedral in 2027, we are limited to exploring its exterior for the time being.

PAYMENT

- 20% of the total tour cost to be deposited upon commitment of the tour. This deposit is non-refundable.
- 80% of the total tour cost to be paid 46 days prior to arrival date.

- 100% of the total tour is required 45 days prior departure or within 24 hours of confirmation if travelling within 45 days from departure.

CANCELLATION: Any cancellations must be made in witting.

- Non-refundable deposit 20% for all confirmed booking.
