## DETAILED ITINERARY



### Day 1 - Monday 22 Jun 2026: Siem Reap Arrival @TBA (Own tickets), Transfer to Hotel

Welcome to Cambodia!

Upon arrival new **Siem Reap Angkor International Airport (SAI)**, after clearing all customs procedures, walk to the main exit gate, you will be met by Trails of Indochina representative carrying Trails of Indochina signboard with your name on it. If you are unable to locate the representative, please call our Customer Care Manager for immediate assistance on **(+855-89) 666 527**. Transfer from airport to your hotel.

***Approx. duration: 1.5 hours to Siem Reap city center depending on traffic***

### Day 2 - Tuesday 23 Jun 2026: Sunrise visit to Angkor Wat, Sunset cruise on Tonle Sap

**04:45** Visit Angkor Wat, one of the wonders of the ancient world. Be amazed by the sheer size of the temple and learn how the **Khmer Empire** prospered between the 9th and 13th centuries, around the time when Angkor Wat was built. Stroll through the **intricately carved hallways** that show hundreds of fine carvings and discover small shrines still in use today by the local people. Witness the sunrise at the best time of the day in the ancient complex, then back to your hotel for breakfast (or enjoy the packed breakfast by the hotel).

#### NOTES:

- Approx. duration: 3 hours (30-minute transfer; 2.5-hour experience)

Starting in the late afternoon, be ready for your transfer to Chhong Kneas, a trading port of agricultural products on the edge of Tonle Sap Lake also known as the Great Lake of Cambodia. Embark on a private local boat, and set out on a relaxing and insightful sunset cruise on the lake. Enjoy a selection of beers and soft drinks, while you observe the local lifestyle of the people living on the lake in their floating and stilted homes. Towards the end of the day, the activity on the lake picks up as people return from their fish farms to present and sell their catch at the local market. Continue to the open waters and take in sunset before returning to the port for a transfer back to Siem Reap town.

Stop at the Kizuna Bridge, Cambodia's first bridge over the Mekong, symbolizing unity and progress.

Continue to the hotel for fellowship or rest.

Have meals with local family.

#### **Day 5 - Friday 26 Jun 2026: Kampong Cham – Prey Veng – Phnom Penh**

Transfer to Prey Veng (1.5 hours), a peaceful town less visited by tourists. Explore Prey Veng Market, a lively local hub where your group can observe the everyday life of Cambodians.

Stop at Neak Loeung Bridge for a scenic break and photo opportunity over the Mekong River.

Visit Chhvang Catholic Church in Kandal Province to witness rural Christian life.

Continue to Phnom Penh (2 hours). Check in to your hotel and enjoy a group dinner (own arranged) or evening devotion.

**Day 6 - Saturday 27 Jun 2026: Journey through the history of Phnom Penh**

Nestled on the banks of the **Tonle Sap and Mekong Rivers**, Phnom Penh, with its 1.5 million residents, stands as Cambodia's enduring capital, a legacy of French colonial influence. In its heyday, this city earned the moniker "Pearl of Asia," celebrated as one of the most enchanting French-built urban centers in Indochina. As the sun bathes the streets in soft morning light, embark on a full day's journey to uncover the rich tapestry of this city, a harmonious blend of Khmer heritage and colonial elegance.

Begin your day at **Wat Phnom**, where the legend of Lady Penh, the city's visionary founder, comes to life. Next, venture into the **Royal Palace**, a regal testament to Khmer architecture. Dive into Cambodia's past at the National Museum, an architectural jewel with roots in Khmer design, designed by a French archaeologist and painter in 1917. Here, the annals of **Khmer art** and sculptures across different epochs of Cambodian history await your discovery.

After a morning of cultural immersion, savor a delightful lunch at a local eatery. In the afternoon, delve into the darker chapters of Cambodia's history, a somber journey through the **Khmer Rouge** era. Your first stop is **Tuol Sleng**, a former high school turned harrowing interrogation prison, bearing the grim moniker S-21 during the Khmer Rouge reign. Now a poignant genocide museum, its chilling corridors whisper the stories of countless souls who suffered within these walls. A short drive takes you to **Cheung Ek**, a sprawling memorial that commemorates the 17,000 victims of Khmer Rouge leader **Pol Pot**, immortalized in the film "The Killing Fields." Though these visits serve as haunting reminders of a harrowing past, they also shed light on the indomitable spirit of the Cambodian people as they persevered and rebuilt their nation.

**NOTES:**

- Approx. duration: 8 hours (1,5-hour transfer; 6,5-hour experience)
- Availability: The Royal Palace and Silver Pagoda are open from 08:00 to 10:30 and 14:00 to 17:00 but are subject to closure at short notice in the event of official ceremonies. If the sites are closed, the guide will make changes to the itinerary on the day.

- Women should cover their shoulders and both men and women should cover their knees. A respectful and humble demeanor is requested when visiting the Toul Sleng Genocide Museum and the Killing Fields.

## GENERAL BOOKING CONDITIONS

### PAYMENT

- 20% of the total tour cost to be deposited upon commitment of the tour. **This deposit is non-refundable.**
- 80% of the total tour cost to be paid 46 days prior to arrival date.
- 100% of the total tour is required 45 days prior departure or within 24 hours of confirmation if travelling within 45 days from departure.

**CANCELLATION:** Any cancellations must be made in writing.

- Non-refundable deposit 20% for all confirmed booking.
- 21 - 15 days prior to arrival date: 50% of the total tour cost
- 14 - 8 days prior to arrival date: 75% of the total tour cost
- 7 days or less prior to arrival date: 100% of the total tour cost

#### VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR ARRIVAL BY AIR

Please ensure your passport is valid more than 6 months from the date of return for every country you are visiting. Please also ensure there is sufficient space in your passport to allow for all immigration procedures, taking note that some South East Asian countries take up a full page for the visa sticker and need yet more space on a separate page for entry & exist stamps.
